Example findings

Data point	Status	Example evidence	Action
Manufacturer identity	Complete	EU Declaration of Conformity	Keep revision-controlled source.
Unique product identifier	Complete	ERP master data	Confirm DPP identifier mapping.
Recycled content	Verify	Supplier declaration	Obtain current evidence and applicability.
Carbon-footprint evidence	Missing	-	Confirm current legal applicability and required format.
Document revision control	Missing	-	Add source register and revision/date fields.

Illustrative output pack

- Requirement matrix with source and status for each reviewed data point.
- Source register linking values to controlled documents.
- Supplier dependency list with requested evidence and owners.
- Structured dataset prepared for handover to a DPP implementation route.
- Executive summary of missing, verify and implementation decisions.

Recommended next actions

- Close critical missing evidence before platform configuration.
- Assign a named internal owner to each supplier-dependent field.
- Agree the DPP hosting/registration route separately from the data-preparation work.
- Define who updates lifecycle data after the passport goes live.
